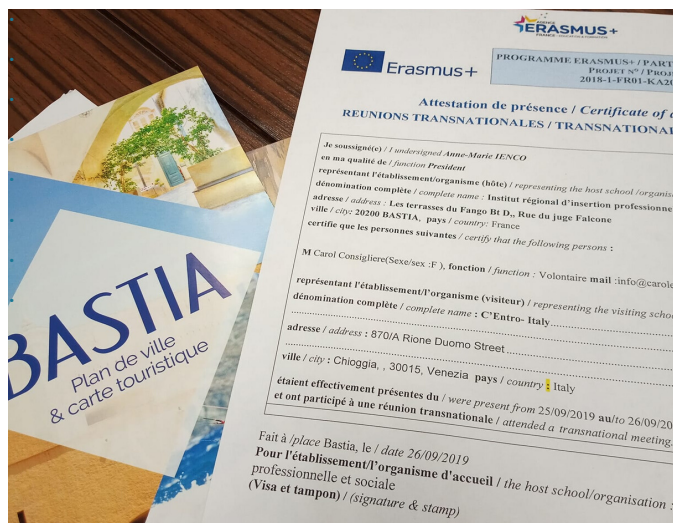


Forum Silver Economy
